## Gemini 105MC

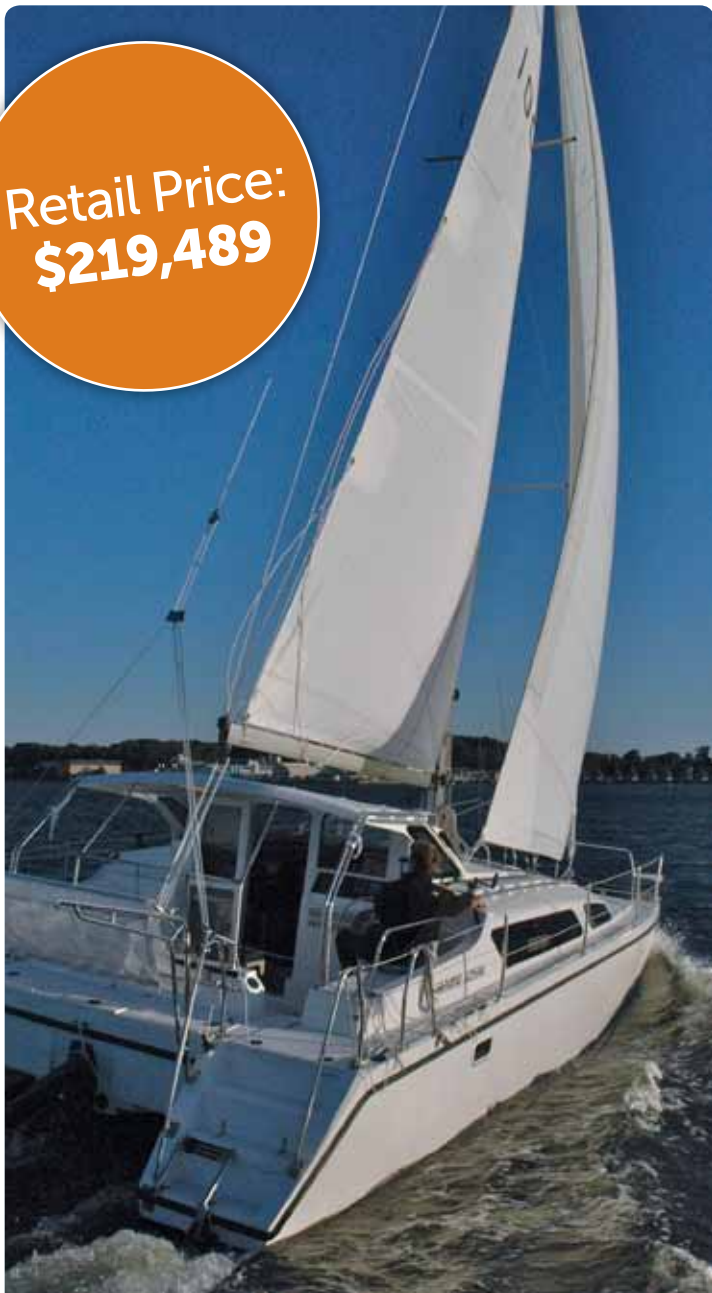
It's not just the attractive lines you notice when you first see the Gemini 105Mc, you'll also note the manageable size of this beautiful multihull. With just under 34' in length and a modest 14' beam it's hard to imagine that it has voluminous living and entertaining space. But it does!

The cockpit leads straight into the bridgedeck salon and a large U shaped dining area. The airy, open salon makes quite an impression with all the natural light streaming through the windows. There's also luxurious cherry woodwork throughout which gives the entire boat an elegant look and feel. With a huge master cabin and plenty of storage space sprinkled throughout, this multihull is ideal for any liveaboard excursion.

- Three cabins and a convertible dinette sleeps up to 8 comfortably
- Nicely equipped galley includes a microwave and a large refrigerator
- Centerboards retract easily for downwind sailing or navigating shallow waterways
- Asymmetric centerboard design enables the boat to point closer to the wind

Performance Cruising, Inc. was by designer Tony Smith shortly after he moved his manufacturing facility from the UK to the USA. Initially building Telstar trimarans, the Gemini was introduced shortly after production began in Annapolis, Maryland in the early 80's and ever since, has proved to be a favorite choice for multihull fans.

With an attractive purchase price, and built with a modest beam that's easy to dock in any marina, Gemini catamarans are extremely popular for those looking for speed, comfort and stability in their sailboat.

With a low center of gravity and kick-up centerboards the boat even performs well when sailing to windward.

Simply put, the Gemini 105 Mc catamaran is designed with broad appeal for sailors who want plenty of room, easy handling and good performance each time they set out to go cruising.
